Stephen Moore is an economist and a founder of the Committee to Unleash Prosperity, a nonpartisan organization founded to promote supply-side policies and economic growth. Mr. Moore formed the Committee in 2015 alongside co-founders Steve Forbes and Art Laffer.

Mr. Moore also currently serves as a distinguished fellow in economics at the Heritage Foundation, where he advances public policies to help the United States retain its position as the global economic superpower. He also advises Members of Congress on budget, fiscal, and monetary policy.

Previously, Mr. Moore founded the Club for Growth, one of the most influential forces for pro-growth policy reform in Washington DC, and the Free Enterprise Fund. Mr. Moore also spent many years as the senior economic commentator on The Wall Street Journal editorial board. He appears regularly on national television and radio programs.

Mr. Moore received a bachelor of arts degree from University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. He holds a Master's of Arts in Economics from George Mason University.
