

Putin's Ukraine War: A Decorated U.S. Army General's Analysis

About the Speaker



General Jack Keane is a foreign policy and national security expert who provides analysis and commentary and serves as an advisor to CEOs and senior management for several public and private companies as well as senior government officials to include the president, cabinet officials and members of congress. He is a member of numerous boards and foundations, serving as Chairman of the Institute for the Study of War and a member of the prestigious Secretary of Defense Policy Board and the 2022 Congressional Commission on the National Defense Strategy. General Keane, a four-star general, completed 37 years of public service in December 2003, culminating in his appointment as acting Chief of Staff and Vice Chief of Staff of the U.S. Army. As the chief operating officer of the Army for more than 4 years, he directed 1.5 million soldiers and civilians in 120 countries. General Keane was in the Pentagon on 9/11 and provided oversight and support for the wars in Afghanistan and Iraq. General Keane is a career infantry paratrooper, a combat veteran of the Vietnam War decorated for valor, who spent much of his military life in operational commands, including command of the famed 101st Airborne Division (Air Assault) and the legendary 18th Airborne Corps, the Army's largest warfighting organization. Among his numerous awards, General Keane was the first military leader to be honored with the Ronald Reagan Peace Through Strength Award and in March of 2020 General Keane was presented with the Presidential Medal of Freedom at the White House.
