He came to international forme at the age of 22 as the youngest world chess champion in history in 1985. Kasparov's famous marches against the IBM super-computer Deep Blue in 1978-97 were key to brigging artificial intelligence, and chess, into the mainstream.

The Soviet sports authorities frequently pressured Kaparov for daring to use his chest fame to criticize the Communist system. Bringing together leaders and representatives from across the political spectime, 8DI has become a leading vaice for political return and standing up for democratic values against authoritation regimes and influences worldwide.

In 2016, he was named a Security Ambassador by Avail Saftware where he discusse cybersecurity and digital rights. Since 1990, Kasparov has been a regular contributor to many major publications, including The Wall Street Jounnal, The Washington Post, ChN, and the New York Daily News. Kasparov's book <u>How Life imitates Chess</u> on strategy and decision-making is available in over 20 languages. Kasparov's prescient book <u>Winter</u> & <u>Coming</u>, Why Valcalin's PLIN and the Enemies of the Free World Must Be Stopped, was released in 2015. His latest book on Al and the human-machine relationship is <u>Deep Thinking</u>; Where Machine Intelligence Ends and Human Creativity Begins (2017).
